# What to Bring to Year 7 Camp

#### Reminder! On Wednesday, 22 May, 2024:

- Meet on the Basketball Courts by 8.15am with your luggage for roll call
- If you are sick on Wednesday morning your parent/carer MUST ring the school
- If you require prescription medication and have indicated this on your medical consent form, you must bring this to Ms Marquis on Wednesday morning at the Basketball Courts. Your medication MUST be in a zip lock plastic bag, with your name, the dosage and time of day the dosage occurs clearly written and a passport size photo included!

Everyone coming to camp needs:

### Clothes

- Clothes for three days this must be appropriate clothing, no midriff tops, singlet tops, short shorts or miniskirts. Acceptable clothes: jeans, tracksuits, leggings, t-shirts [long and short sleeves]
- Underwear and socks
- Wet weather gear or a raincoat
- Jacket and jumper [it gets cold in the evening!]
- Covered shoes [thongs or sandals are not permitted]
- A spare pair of shoes [in case it is raining!]
- Plastic bags for wet clothes/towel

### Overnight

- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Toiletries [toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap]
- Towel
- Pyjamas
- Torch

### During the day [in your backpack]

- Water bottle [can be refilled at camp]
- Hat and sunscreen
- Tissues
- Hand sanitiser

### What not to bring!

- Speakers for playing music/video cameras/GoPros
- Power boards
- Excessive amounts of junk food one zip lock bag of junk food only!
- Any food containing nuts

Remember to pack wisely – only bring the essentials, you are only going for three days!!!



## Remember!!

It is strongly advised that mobile phones are not brought to camp. The teachers can call parents/carers if required, students do not need to bring phones. If you bring mobile phones or cameras or any expensive items to camp, the school will NOT be held liable if these items are damaged, lost or stolen. These items are to be brought at your own risk and are your responsibility. Students will only be allowed to access phones when instructed by supervising teachers. At all other times, all phones will be switched off and out of sight. If a student does not follow these instructions, phones will be confiscated and locked in a teacher's room until we leave camp. All other digital devices such as speakers, MP3 players are not permitted.
