



With emails finally working and DET providing further information, this update should hopefully answer some questions about what next week will look like for students and staff.

As reported in the media, students will be 'Learning from Home' for the first week of Term 3 commencing on Tuesday 13 July. The NSW Government has provided the following advice for schools in Greater Sydney:

For the first week of Term 3, students in Greater Sydney – that is, those LGAs currently affected by NSW Health stay-at-home orders – will be learning from home. This will stay in place until Friday 16 July.

*Schools will remain open for the students and families who need it, although **parents are encouraged to keep their children at home.***

There will only be minimal staff supervision and schools will provide one unit of work for students, whether they are learning from home or in the classroom.

***All staff and Secondary School students who attend school will be required to wear masks.** This is consistent with current requirements for masks to be worn in office and workplace settings and on transport services across Greater Sydney.*

Any student or staff member with any symptoms, or who is feeling unwell, should not attend school and should take a COVID test immediately. Anyone who has been off sick from school will be required to return a negative COVID test before being permitted to return to school.

How will this advice be implemented at Picnic Point High School	
Learning onsite at school	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The school will be open with very limited staff onsite to look after any students that arrive to school. No student will be turned away.• Supervision will be provided by casual staff with executive providing support.• Students learning onsite will be assigned a space in the library with a computer device and must strictly stay in this space for learning.• Students will follow the Learning from Home timetable and will zoom into their own classes as students learning from home will do.• Teachers will deliver their lessons from home via the various learning platforms.
Guidelines for staff and students onsite	Students and staff onsite will be required to follow strict guidelines as per NSW government regulations. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Masks must be worn at all times when indoors.• Strict compliance to 1.5m social distancing.• No sharing of equipment or personal devices.• Please bring your own hand sanitiser and tissues.
Playground Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No ball games or other games permitted.• The 2-person rule when outdoors, will apply in external areas of the school at recess/lunch.• All bubblers in the school are not operational until further notice. Students may continue to fill their water bottles using the chilled water stations as usual.
Canteen	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The canteen will be closed until further notice.
Equipment required	All students must bring the following equipment to school for learning: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Face Mask• Fully charged Laptop/device for Learning• Headphones• Other equipment needed for learning – course books, textbooks etc• Lunch and Water Bottle
Behaviour	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students will be required to follow all instructions and guidelines.• Students must comply with School Common Values: Respect, Responsibility & Participation.
Unwell students	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students who attend school with even mildest of symptoms will be sent home immediately.• Students will need to provide a copy of a negative COVID-19 test result before being permitted to return to school.• Students with recurrent symptoms require a medical certificate.
