



Peer Support Program

The break in the weather was greatly welcomed by our Year 10 Peer Leaders who on Friday 11 March, met their Year 7 student groups and commenced the Peer Support Program.

What is the Peer Support Program?

The Peer Support Program provides a fun and engaging environment for young people to address social issues. Modules are designed to equip young people with skills to deal proactively with life experiences. The Peer Support Program promotes wellbeing which encourages positive relationships, connectedness and a sense of responsibility.

The Module being facilitated by our Year 10 Leaders is 'Rethinking Challenges,' which builds resilience in our students and develops the skills of perseverance, critical thinking, optimism, communication and empathy. The Module runs for 5 periods over 4 weeks.

How does the Peer Support Program work?

Our Year 10 Peer Leaders have completed training that assists them to facilitate structured activities with groups of 10 Year 7 students, supervised by a teacher. This is a great opportunity for our older students to connect and mentor our younger ones.

Friday was filled with lots of fun activities that focused on making connections, working together and learning about Picnic Point High School.
