Dear Parents and Carers

In accordance with the Education Act (1990), time is to be allowed in every government school for the Religious Education of children of any religious persuasion. This 'Special Religious Education' (SRE) is given by an authorised member of the clergy or other religious teacher to those children whose parents elect for their children to participate.

In 2024 Special Religious Education will be offered by a team representing the Combined Protestant Churches of the area (Anglican, Baptist, Congregational, Churches of Christ, Pentecostal, Presbyterian, Uniting etc.) in one seminar per term. Orthodox will also be offered as a separate option.

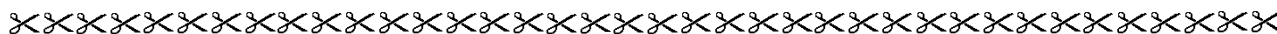
